SOUTH BENDIGO REPORT MAY 19TH 2007

The Woodvale Classic and Club team Challenge was conducted by the South Bendigo Athletic Club with a strong contingent of cross country athletes from all Bendigo Clubs contesting the events at the Woodvale Recreation Reserve with 110 athletes competing.

The day's competition was sponsored by Champions Supa IGA, Bendigo Braves, Hilson Builders, Rob Dixon Glass, Seipolt Cleaning and Ron Nancarrow.

The Open Men's 6.5km event was taken out by top class athlete Brady Threllfall with his Clubmate Tony Morrison in 2nd place and South Bendigo's Russell Fenwick claiming 3rd place with another South Bendigo athlete in Kyall Britten finishing close up 4th.

University athlete Lee McCullagh won the under 20 age group with Bendigo Ymca Clubmates John Maher and Charles Chambers taking out the 40+ and 50+ age groups respectively.

In the Women's 6.5km event Joanne Keely won the Open Womens event with Hannah Blair 2nd and Kirsty Seipolt in 3rd place while the 35+ Women's category was taken out by Anne Buckley with Lyn Crome 2nd and Amanda Worthington in 3rd place in the 6.5km teams challenge the Bendigo Ymca Club won the Men's and Womens section's. sashes were awarded to first over the line in the Mens and Womens categories and they were won by Brady Threllfall and Joanne Keely.

The under 16 & under 14 boys and girls 3.2km race saw a fine victory to South Bendigo's Jesse Noden in the under 16 boys event with 12 year old University athlete Madeleine Evely competing in the under 14 age group the first to finish in the female section with both athletes presented with sashes as the first athletes to finish. Peter Curtis won the under 14 boys event with Cara Jones winning the girls under 16 race.

The Invitation Open Male and female categories for the 3.2km race were won by Bendigo Ymca Clubmates Brett Gilligan and Anna Matthews.

In the team's section's Bendigo Ymca won the boys category by just 1 point over South Bendigo with South Bendigo taking out the girls section.

In the under 10 and under 12 boys and girls 1km race Tom Savage was the first athlete to finish winning the under 12 boys race and the sash for 1st boy across the line. Ebony Whiley won the girls sash as she won the under 12 girls event narrowly from her training partner Celine Mountjoy. The winners of the under 10 sections were Dane Heiden and Demi Goodall-Hoffman with both athletes recording fine performances. University won the teams event over South Bendigo with South Bendigo winning the girls teams section.

The winners of the under 8 500m were Will Noden winning the boys event from Patrick Dove with Bree Heiden taking out the girls race with Madison Bryce close up in 2nd place. South Bendigo won the mixed teams race with Bendigo Ymca in 2nd place.

South Bendigo Athletic Club will conduct cross country races next Saturday in Whipstick Road Lightning Hill Eaglehawk with 6500m, 3000m, 800m and 1500m races commencing at 1-30pm and members are asked to bring afternoon tea to share at the completion of the days races with tea and coffee supplied.
