



## SOUTH GAINS MAJOR SPONSOR

Race three of the South Bendigo Athletic Club's Cross Country season was held at Atlas Road, Junortoun on Saturday afternoon.

Kirsty Seipolt ran a well judged race to win the Hume & Iser / Bicknell's Sports 4000 metre handicap in a time of 19.07 minutes, holding out the fast finishing Neil Britten, with George Austen grabbing the third placed ribbon. Fourth placed Greg Hilson ran the fastest time of 15.26 minutes.

Harrison Bynon, in his second race start, won the Bendigo Toyworld 1000 metres for the under 10 athletes.

Harrison ran a time of 4.59 minutes to win from Will Noden & Madison Bryce, with Brandon Bynon claiming fastest time, nosing out Tom Noden in a sprint finish, with both boys running 4.00 minutes.

The Reilly's Retravision 2000 metre handicap captured the biggest field of the day, with Nine year old Kaitlyn Bryce stepping up to run the long distance and claiming her maiden victory with the club, stopping the clock in 10.32 minutes.
