

CLUB'S OLDEST ATHLETE WINS MEMORIAL EVENT

The South Bendigo Athletic Club held it's final club race of the season on Saturday, being the 16th Annual Donna Tickell Memorial 1500 metres Sealed Handicap at the Woodvale Recreation Reserve.

It was 77 year old Keith Noden that took the honours, winning the event in a time of 8.37 minutes, 38 seconds under the estimated time.

Second & third placings went to the Hilson brothers. Seven year old Jake finished second in 6.30 minutes, 30 seconds under the estimated time, with 9 year old Kyle in third place with a time of 7.53 minutes.

A field of thirty athletes lined up for the event, with 1996 winner Ryan Cornell running the fastest time of 4.35 minutes to finish 7th on handicap.

Two time race winner Kyall Britten ran the second fastest time of 4.39 minutes to be 5th on handicap, with Greg Hilson third fastest in 4.51 minutes.

The top ten athletes ran under their estimated time, these also included Madison Bryce, Maria Bryce, Ian Self, Kirsty Seipolt & Holly Hawke.
