The South Bendigo Athletics Club's Champions SUPA IGA Cross Country Season continued on Saturday with 3 Club races held at Golf Course Road Epsom.

The first event of the day the Bicknell's Sport 4000m was taken out in a close finish by Mandy Worthington just in front of the fast finishing John Justice with Joel LeBusque having his first run with the Club in 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Russell Fenwick won the fastest time award with Kirsty Seipolt the fastest female. Other first time runners to show out included Natalie Rumbiolo and Peter Lebusque.

In the Reilly's Retravision 2000m Celine Mountjoy ran brilliantly to win her 2<sup>nd</sup> race for the Season and also captured the fastest female award as she sprinted away from the opposition with a decisive victory, Nigel Self took 2<sup>nd</sup> place and Ross Matheson claimed 3<sup>rd</sup> with Russell Fenwick taking fastest time honours for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time for the day, 12 year old Rochelle Kennedy from Kyneton having her first run with the Club also produced a fine performance to be the 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest female.

Harrison Bynon scored a top class victory in the 1000m which was also his 2<sup>nd</sup> Club race win for the Season as he cruised to the line ahead of Thomas Hawke with Tom Noden taking 3<sup>rd</sup> place with fastest time and Brianna Marron the fastest female.
